Kinship Care Support Program

(KCSP)

The Kinship Care Support Program is a **financial assistance** program for adults who are raising children, other than your own, who are related to you. If you are a grandparent, aunt, uncle, step grandparent etc, who has a limited income and has one or more children living with you, in your home. You may qualify for help from the Kinship Care Support Program.

These funds may be used for:

- Basic needs (food, shelter, clothes, gas etc.)
- Legal Services
- Transportation
- Interpreter Services
- Assistive Technology Devices/Durable Medical Equipment/Medications
- Supervision for children during kinship caregiver appointment
- Other
